Big Question for Apple Class: What makes a person a hero?

Whole school Enquiry: 'Pyramid Builders' Who were the greatest pyramid builders and what else did they achieve?

<u>Maths</u>	White Rose Maths Scheme and Mastering Numbers. This term's units are To 20 and beyond, How Many Now? Sharing and Grouping, Exploring 3d Shapes, Manipulate, Compose and Decompose Shapes, Visualise, Build and Map, and Make Connections.
<u>R.E.</u>	Christianity (Celebrations & Spirituality) Buddhists, Jewish and Muslim Special Places.
<u>Science</u>	Notice processes and changes in the world around us - summer season (ongoing throughout the term) Know some similarities and differences in contrasting environments (Argentina).
<u>RSHE</u>	This term's units are Being My Best and Growing and Changing.
<u>P.E.</u>	A (agility), B (balance), C (co-ordination) through Fun and Games and Ball Skills.
<u>Understanding the World</u>	Some similarities and differences between things in the past and now (linked to Florence Nightingale), Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries (linked to Messi from Argentina): find Argentina on the globe and in the atlas. Learn about the landscape, animals, food, weather.
<u>Expressive Arts and Design.</u>	Painting paint a bowl of fruit (colour mixing). Design and make a superhero cape. Printing pop art in the style of Andy Warhol
<u>Music</u>	Listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound. Learn rhymes, poems and songs.
