| <u>English</u> | Drawing Club adventures. Traditional Tales- The Three Billy Goats Gruff, Robin Hood, Goldilocks, Rapunzel and Jack and the Beanstalk. Picture Books – A Dark, Dark Tale, Little Rabbit Foo Foo, Not Now Bernard, and The Odd Egg. Animations - Wilo' the Wisp and Captain Pugwash. We will learn to form lower-case and capital letters correctly, spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s, and write short sentences with words with known letter-sound correspondences using a capital letter and full stop. We will work towards re-reading what we have written to check that it makes sense. |
| <u>Maths</u> | White Rose Maths Scheme and Mastering Numbers. This term's units are Alive in 5, Mass and Capacity, Growing 6, 7 and 8, Length, Height and Time, Building 9 and 10, Explore 3d shapes. |
| <u>R.E.</u> | Special Times and Places; Christianity and celebrations. |
| <u>Science</u> | Plant seeds and care for growing plants, respect the natural environment and living things, know and understand some lifecycles, know and understand some important processes and changing states of matter. |
