Apple Class Parents Information

As you are preparing for your child to start at Bleasby CE Primary School I thought I would put together some information that you might find useful.

- Term dates - these can be found on our school website www.bleasbyprimary.org.uk under the Parents tab - Term Dates.
- Uniform - all uniform bearing a Bleasby School logo can be purchased through www.brigade.uk.com or schooltrends.co.uk. Please see the links on the school website (Parents tab - useful information - school uniform). Many supermarkets also sell uniform in Bleasby school colours. It is useful to send a change of clothes, in case of an accident, in their book bags, especially pants and socks/tights. **PLEASE ENSURE ALL UNIFORM IS CLEARLY NAMED.** There is information on a label website in the same uniform section on the website.
- P.E kits include white Bleasby logo T-shirt, navy blue shorts, trainers (not plimsolls please) and navy tracksuit for winter months. **These should all be named.** Children will come to school wearing their P.E kit on their allocated P.E day. School P.E bags can be purchased from Brigade.
- School book bags can be purchased through the same uniform suppliers. Please can I request that you buy the smaller size which fit inside our trays and make things much easier for your child to become independent. **We do not have room in the classroom or cloakroom for large rucksack style bags.**
- If your child is going to be off poorly, please phone the school office and leave a message as soon as you can on the day of their absence. Information regarding reporting of absences and guidance on infection control can also be found on the school website. For sickness bugs we do require that your child is off for 48 hours to limit the risk of spreading.
- Please provide a **named** water bottle for your child which will be sent home at the end of each week. School policy is for the children to only have water, not juice.
- Named wellies and waterproofs are required for Wild Wednesdays. Again, if these could stay in school it would be much appreciated.
- Your child will be given a Reading Diary (Monkey Book) with their reading book. Each week I will include a weekly overview so that you know what will be happening with regards to our learning along with any special dates or extra information. Please can you read with your child as much as possible and **record** this in their diary. We are following the DfE reading Framework, so books will be changed once a week. This will be on a Friday. Please

keep the reading books in your child's book bag because we read with the children regularly during the school week.

- Milk - all children under the age of 5 years receive free milk (although you do have register your own child through the Cool Milk website) and a piece of fruit which we have mid-morning. Once the children turn 5, there is a small charge for the milk.
- Dinner - most of Reception and KS1 have school dinners which are free of charge. There is a 3 weekly menu which can be found on the school website. The midday supervisors encourage the children to try different foods, but we monitor this and if we or you feel they would prefer a packed lunch from home, then that is fine. All school dinners must be ordered by yourselves a week in advance using the SchoolMoney system. There is a choice everyday between a main meal, vegetarian option, or a jacket potato. Each dinner option comes with a pudding.

Term starts on **Wednesday 3rd September 2025**. Our new starters will have a phased introduction into school on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of that week. Please bring your child to the main door by the office and collect them from the same place. The week commencing Monday 8th September, the children will be full time - please use the side gate, which opens at 8.40am, where I will meet them. We will finish at 3.30pm and see you on the playground. You can access school from the side gate.

Wednesday 3rd - 9.15am - 11.45am.

Thursday 4th - 1.15pm - 3.15pm.

Friday 5th - 10.00am - 2.00pm please bring a packed lunch.
